How do I participate?

The first thing you need to do is request a login to the scheduling page. You can make that request by sending an email to W5L@nelarc.org. You will be notified when a login has been set up for you.

Once you have your login you can go to the scheduling page found at (<http://NELARC.org/2019-W5L>) and log in. On that page you can reserve day/time/band/mode slots in which you want to operate. Please note that the time slots are two hours each.

W5L Operator Guidelines

With your time slot reserved, get on the air! Be sure to log each contact with a logging program capable of generating an ADIF file of your results. A couple of suggested programs would be N1MM Logger+ or N3FJP Amateur Contact Log. If you use N1MM Logger+ you can use the DXpedition contest which contains all the information you would need in an ADIF file for LOTW. When you are through with your time slot operation, email the ADIF of those contacts to W5L@nelarc.org. Be sure your callsign is referenced in the email.

Always be courteous, remembering that you are representing the State of Louisiana.

How can I get confirmation of a contact?
